About **for dementia**

Dementia is an important issue that we all need to take very seriously. It is an illness that can affect anyone with an increasing risk in later life (that's 1 in 5 people over 80, and 1 in 20 people over 65). Around 700,000 people in the UK today are experiencing the effects of a condition, such as Alzheimer's, vascular dementia, Lewy Body syndrome, which causes dementia. People with dementia will usually live for many years with the condition and, for most of the duration of their illness, will be cared for in their own homes by their families and friends and their local communities. **for dementia** is committed to improving standards of care and quality of life for all those affected by dementia.

Admiral Nurses are specialist mental health nurses who offer individual psychological and practical support to carers from the time of diagnosis for as long as necessary. They also provide consultancy and advice to other professionals working in the field, and work to raise awareness of the immense stresses and strains that caring for someone with dementia brings. Since its foundation in 1994, **for dementia** (formerly known as the Dementia Relief Trust) has set up teams of Admiral Nurses in several areas of the country, and it is our aim to reach out to carers of people with dementia right across the U.K. Each team of two nurses costs about £100,000 a year to maintain, and we constantly need to raise funds to support existing services as well as to expand our network and carry out the research and evaluation we need to undertake.

for dementia training is the training services arm of the charity and offers high quality affordable training in all issues relevant to the care of older people and people with dementia, with a particular focus on the unqualified care sector. *for dementia training* has built up a wide repertoire of courses and is the only organisation to offer the Westminster Diploma in Dementia Care, accredited by the London Open College Network. Funds are needed to ensure that we can continue to offer a wide range of courses at a reasonable cost to care workers.

The **for dementia Carers' Network** was developed by a group of carers to create a national network to bring the perspective and influence of carers to bear on the work of the charity in a variety of ways. The Carers' Network has, to date, distributed newsletters, organised a carers' outing and delivered a series of workshops designed to build carers' confidence and encourage carers to tell their stories. The Network was established through an After Dementia Millennium Award from the Alzheimer's Society, but additional funding is needed to ensure the continuation of this important new resource for carers and former carers.
